In 2002 The Broadway Rose Theatre Company produced Stuart Ross' *Forever Plaid*, a musical revue consisting of mellow, popular songs from the 1950s and 60s framed with the story of four somewhat nerdish friends forming their own singing group and harmonizing just for the sheer joy of it. Tragically, the group is killed in an accident when their car collides with a bus of Catholic teenagers, but lucky for them, they're sent back to Earth to perform the

show they never got to do in life.

This holiday season our favorite squeaky-clean 1960's guy group is back again with *Plaid Tidings*. Once more they are allowed to slip through the thinning ozone layer to return to Earth on "an undisclosed mission to perform Harmonal duties." At least part of their mission involves creating a Plaids Christmas Special as their idol, Perry Como, used to do. In addition to old songs like: "Stranger in Paradise," "Sh-Boom," "Amor," "Mambo Italiano," "Hey There," and "Bésame Mucho," we are also treated to a snowstorm of classic holiday songs: "Let It Snow," "Carol of the Bells," "Joy to the World," "Beginning to Look a Lot Like Christmas," "I'll Be Home for Christmas," and "Twuz Tha Nite B4 Xmas," a hip-hop rendering of the famous poem. The boys also whip up a Plaid Caribbean Christmas that puts the "Day-O" in Excelsis! Plus a hilarious tribute to The Ed Sullivan Christmas Spectaculars featuring the Rockettes, the Chipmunks, and The Vienna Boys Choir all in 3 minutes and 11 seconds! A holiday treat for the whole family.

The production was written by Stuart Ross and will be directed and choreographed by Dan Murphy with musical direction by Jeffery Childs. Singing the crystalline harmonies will be Jeremy Sloan, Matthew Brown, Robert Head, and Sean Powell.

The creative team also includes Chris Whitten (*Scenic Designer*), Allison Dawe (*Costume Designer*), Bearclaw Hart (*Lighting Designer*), Tim Richey (*Sound Designer*), Deb Dahling (*Prop Designer*), and Jessica Downs (*Production Stage Manager*).

Plaid Tidings will be performed at the **Broadway Rose New Stage**.
