The story was born out of a graduate school assignment to write about a group of people to whom he related most. The play was featured at the National Alliance for Musical Theatre's 2009 Festival of New Plays, and received its world premiere at Goodspeed Musicals in 2010.

Isaac Lamb will direct the Broadway Rose production, with musical direction by Mont Chris Hubbard and choreography by Dan Murphy. The creative team also includes Sean O'Skea (*Scenic Designer*), Allison Dawe (*Costume Designer*), Gene Dent (*Lighting Designer*), Tim Richey (*Sound Designer*), Deb Dahling (*Prop Designer*), and Jessica Downs (*Production Stage Manager*).

The cast includes Ryan Andrews as Elliot, Danielle Purdy as Laura, Zach Cossman as Jake, Erin Charles as Nicole, Amy Jo Halliday as Principal Dixon, and Joe Theissen as music teacher Mr. Hornsby.
