I Left My Heart features the four decades of music that Bennett recorded, including his early top-40 hits, jazz recordings with Basie, Stan Getz, and Bill Evans, torch songs, film scores, and his now-infamous *MTV Unplugged* performance, which introduced him to a whole new generation of listeners. Sprinkled through with biographical tidbits and anecdotes, The revue sports a thrilling score of 33 Bennett standards, including: "Because Of You," "Stranger In Paradise," "Top Hat, White Tie And Tails," "The Best Is Yet To Come," "Cold, Cold Heart," "I Wanna Be Around," "The Good Life," "Rags To Riches," and his best-known hit, "I Left My Heart In San Francisco."

Three singers pay tribute to Tony Bennett rather than impersonating the legend: Fred Bishop, Yohannes Murphy and Todd Tschida. *I Left My Heart* is directed by Sharon Maroney with musical direction by Rick Lewis and choreography by Dan Murphy.
