Below are some advisories for sensory- and content-sensitive patrons.



## Mild Audience Interaction

The musical begins with loud music and actors roaming about the stage and auditorium. During some songs, actors may approach the audience or encourage the audience to sing or clap along to the music.



## Loud Noises from a Drumkit

The character Svec, who wears the red tracksuit, plays the drums very loudly during one song in Act II. It sometimes sounds like loud popping.



## Adult Themes

The show contains frequent use of strong profanity, mature content, and alcohol use. The show also has adult themes of love, death, and sexuality.



## Emotional Music

The music is loud and powerful during some songs, but soft and emotional during others.
