Completing the production team is Finn Meader as stage manager.

The cast is comprised of Jason Nuesa as Jack, Melissa Standley as Mother, Dylan Anthony Macabitas as Minstrel and Bean Guy, Benicio Delgado as Lucky and Goose, Brie Graham as Cook, and Heath Koerschgen as Giant.
